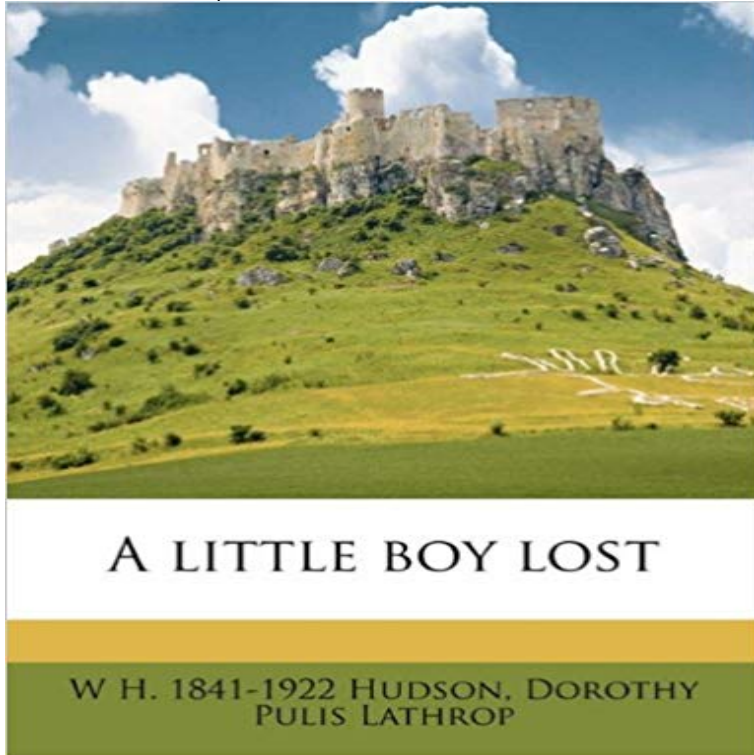


A little boy lost
